
How to Order


Getting Started

Training

Your retailer support begins from the minute you place your first order. We want to make sure you're receiving as much help as you need. We offer two training options to help you learn everything you need to know about Plaster Paint.

First option: Visit our Youtube channel and watch the training videos provided. Once you're through them all, we will arrange a conference call with you to go over any questions you have, or solidify any of the techniques shown.

Second option: Sometimes you just need to meet in person! Layne is available to travel for personal one-on-one training. This training includes two full days. The first day we will go over product knowledge, paining techniques, and selling points. That evening or the next day, Layne will help you host your first paint class. The second day you will run another class. Flights must be provided, or mileage covered if the drive is under four hours, as well as a \$500 training fee. Please note, most often the profits from the two classes will help cover the cost of this valuable training.



Once you are signed up, we will ask you which training method you'd prefer. You can access the Youtube videos at any time, and the option to do the in-person training is always available. And, of course, as you're selling, we are always just a phone call or email away if you have any questions or want to learn a new technique!

You'll also be able to join the Plaster Paint Canada Private Retailers group on Facebook. There you will be able to interact with other retailers and Layne and Matt about tricks, tips, ideas and questions about Plaster Paint Products.

Setting Up Your Display

A display that is set up in a way that is appealing to the eye while also making products easy to see, find, and understand is the first step in making a sale.

When setting up your Plaster Paint product, the best way for your customers to view and understand your paint is to display it in its individual product groupings. That means Original Plaster Paint all together, One Step together, Sealants together, and so on. Then put each individual colour together within that product group. This way the customer sees each color and what sizes are available in each color. Sometimes tipping one jar on its side so the customer can view the color helps too.

I like using our plaster paint posters that give a quick explanation of what each product is and does, just in case the customer views the product when you're tied up and can't give your explanation right away. These posters are included in your retailer kit.



Having a piece of furniture painted in the colors you sell helps the customer see the live version of the paint.



Selling Plaster Paint Products

The most important tool needed to sell paint is knowledge. Understand your paint and why it works. We will guide you with as much knowledge as we can give you, so please make sure you take advantage of the training programs we offer. If you can, take the time to read blogs and any other info you can find on chalk paints, latex paints, and oil paints. You will understand what paints go together, their properties and how they work. Check out our Plaster Paint Blog to learn about different kinds of brushes and paints.

Sometimes customers are hesitant to ask questions about your paint or product. The best way to break the silence without seeming pushy is to first say "hello", never "how may I help you". Ask yourself how may sales people ask you that question and what is almost always your response. "Just looking, thanks!" Instead, say hello and ask an open ended question. Here are a few of my favourites:

- "Have you tried plaster paint before?"
- "Have you chalk painted before?"
- "This paint is really cool, did you know you can put it on just about anything... pre-painted surfaces, glass, wood, metal, you name it. And no priming and sanding!"
- "If you've tried other chalk paint brands you will love our product. You'll never go back."
- "This little jar covers this size of furniture. It's amazing how such a little jar covers so much. A little bit goes a long way."
- "Do you have a piece in mind you're wanting to paint?"

Opening the conversation with a question like these will ensure your customer is open and doesn't feel pressured. They will be more likely follow up with questions.

Another great way to sell is by showing the customer pieces painted with your product. There is no better way to explain a product than showing a finished project. Another idea is to invite them to come to a free paint class. If they are skeptical, this is their chance to really see the product in action.




Understanding Colour

Understanding how colours work together will help you be an extra-successful Plaster Paint Retailer! Gaining a simple understanding of basic colour theory will allow you to be a colour expert for your customers to help them coordinate their project with their home and also enhance your displays by using creative colour combinations.

First, let's look at the Colour Wheel. This shows all colours.



Colour Types:



Primary: Red, yellow and blue. All other colours are a result of mixing these three hues.



Secondary: Orange, green and purple. These are formed by mixing primary colours.



Tertiary: Yellow-orange, red-orange, red-purple, blue-purple, blue-green, yellow-green. These are formed by mixing a primary and a secondary colour.

Now let's mix them together! Here are some common ways to combine colours in a beautiful and cohesive pallet.



Monochromatic

This means using two or more variations of the same colour, either tints (made lighter by adding white) or shades (made darker by adding black).




Analogous

This means using colours that are next to each other on the colour wheel.



Complimentary

This means using colours that are opposite each other on the colour wheel.



Warm or Cool Tones

Mix warm colours for a bright and energetic feel, or cool colours for a more calming and passive tone.



Neutrals

You can never go wrong with a neutral! Neutrals are shades of black, white, brown or grey and pair well with pretty much any colour.
