Text

Titles are best at two lines but three lines can be accomodated.





Descriptions are best at four lines of text, but more can be accomodated.

Spacing

Ample white space between all elements is critical for readability and clarity. This will reduce the 'cluttered' feeling of the Precedent website.

Menu

Since the site's focus is listening and reading, there are no separate pages. The site has one page and the menu is a "Slider". The galaxy image is a placeholder.

"Here's our archive" can, if desired, link to a page where users can browse older content.

Images

The slanted line element can be whatever you want it to be, or you can use this one. A subtle pattern, unlike a uniform background, visually delineates each Media Card.

The "Subscribe" card can stay at the bottom or be placed at regular intervals (after every 5 cards, for example), can live in the footer only or as a popup.
