


Problem



Solution Changing user habits

The new system will replace the MetroCard. Passengers will no longer have to endure frustrating waits in long lines at card - dispensing machines in subway stations, though there will still be machines for people who do not have cellphones or credit or debit cards.

Nor will passengers have to refill their fare cards week after week or month after month. The new system will keep track in an account that riders can check online.

The system will work through Apple Pay, as well as "contactless cards" — credit or debit cards.
