Start with Content

Write Code

2 weeks

With the proposed website information architecture, we'll write the content for each page as well as document a catalog of the products that will be on the site

3 weeks

Using the brand's design system, the visual design of the website will be worked on in static form, similar to layouts for pages in a magazine or a book. Prototypes will be produced to simulate the experience of the site

We'll review and go back and forth on the visual design, and aim to get the content and the visuals full approves before writing a line of code

Design

1-2 month(s)

Once the visual design is approved, development will commence and the site will start coming to life



Launch

Once the site is tested and approved, we'll launch and replace the existing site
